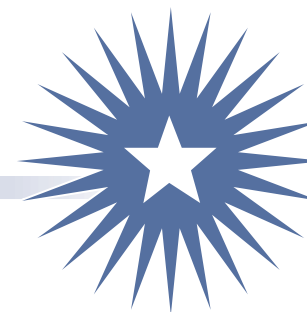

7TH INDO-US EMERGENCY MEDICINE SUMMIT

The 7th Indo-US Emergency Medicine Summit was organized from 28th September to 2nd October 2011 by the Department of Emergency Medicine, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, in collaboration with the University College of Medical Sciences, Delhi, University of South Florida, Tampa, USA and SUNY Downstate, New York, USA.

The Pre-Summit of the Summit was held on 28th & 29th September at the University College of Medical Sciences, New Delhi with the theme of "Medical Response to Mass Casualty & Disaster Management". It was attended by more than 300 delegates from various parts of India.

The theme of the Summit was "Translating Science from Benchside to Bedside and Beyond". It was attended by more than 1400 delegates from all over the world. The delegates included faculty, residents, nurses, students and paramedics. The Summit was inaugurated by Prof. M.K. Bhan, Secretary to the Govt. of India, Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of

Sciences & Technology. Prof. R.C. Deka, Director, AIIMS was the Guest of Honour.

The Summit highlighted relevant and current concepts of Emergency care in a holistic manner. Parallel tracks were organized for Nursing and Paramedical Professionals. This event has proved that assembly of various specialties and students at one-platform is what makes Emergency Medicine an exciting specialty. In addition, six workshops were organized to give practical and hands-on training to the participants.

To acknowledge hard work put in by several dedicated experts in advancing the field of Emergency Medicine, the Academic College of Emergency Experts in India (ACEE-India) and the Academy for Clinical Emergency Nursing in India (ACEN-India) were launched at this Summit. Emergency Nursing in India. Dr. Praveen Aggrawal was nominated as the Founding Dean of ACEE-INDIA while Ms. Shyamala was nominated as the Founding Director of ACEN-India.

The first convocations of the Academic College of Emergency Experts in India (ACEE-India) and the Academy for Clinical Emergency Nursing in India (ACEN-India) were held during the Summit. Ten doctors received the coveted Fellowship of Academic College of Emergency Experts in India while eight nurses received the Fellowship of Academy for Clinical Emergency Nursing in India.

The Academic Council for Emergency and Trauma (ACET) also held its meeting during the Summit. It was attended by 34 Academic Councilors. It was felt that quality Emergency Medical Officer (EMO) workforce was the need of the hour. Since it would take another decade before we can have a sizeable number of residency-trained Emergency Physicians, training of

existing EMO workforce was the only option to provide quality emergency care. ACEE-India was given the responsibility to prepare curriculum for upgrading the skills of existing EMOs.

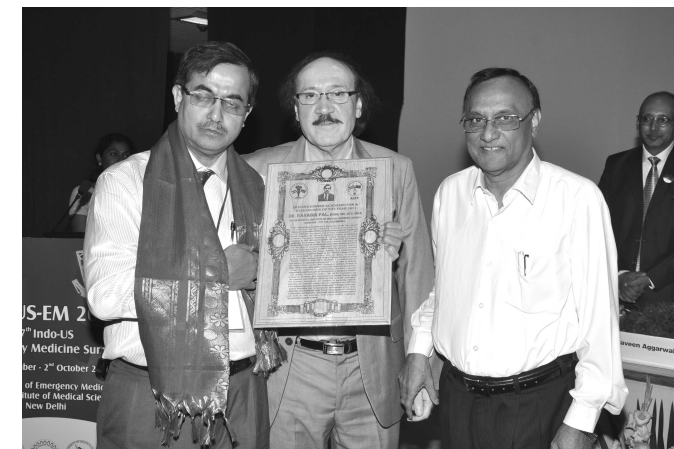
In an effort to boost translational research in Medicine focusing on the area of Critical Illness and Injury, the first meeting of the Indian Network of Critical Illness and Injury Translational Trial Experts (INCIITTE) was held on 1st & 2nd October 2011 at AIIMS, New Delhi. The idea was to bring together Basic Scientists, Clinicians and Public Health Experts at one platform for the benefit of translational science. Researchers from Indian Council for Medical Research, Department of Science and Technology, Department of Biotechnology and Council for Scientific and Industrial Research will be a part of this Network. Investigators from Basic Sciences and fields of Emergency Medicine, Anesthesia, Medicine, Pediatrics & Surgery were invited to be a part of INCIITTE Network. Several research projects with novel ideas were discussed during the meeting. INDUS-EM 2011 created a new development in the field of Emergency Medicine thereby pushing in new leaders to develop the academic science holistically.
