Emergency Airway and Ventilation

This Workshop offered by the AIIMS Airway Laboratory in collaboration with the Airway India Research (AIR) Group. This Training Program will cover Key aspects of achieving Emergency Airway and Accomplishing successful and stable ventilation in Controlled as well as Challenging Scenarios in Emergency and Trauma Medicine. Focus will be equally distributed to cover key practical aspects in all age groups from Pediatric to geriatrics.

Pediatric Emergency and Trauma Sonography

This Training Program focusing on learning key features in using the Emergency Sonogram Technology in the Pediatric Emergency Department and a Busy Trauma Center. Pediatric Sonography is used in Emergency Care to diagnose Gall Bladder Cardiac, Pulmonary, Abdominal Emergencies, Aortic and Vascular Pathology. This workshop will cover key features to techniques for using the right Probes on the right patients to diagnose the right conditions. A considerable amount of time will be spent on hands on training. At the end of the course the Participants will have confidence to use the sonogram in the Pediatric Emergency Department.

Emergency Point of Care Ultrasound in Adults

This Training Program focusing on learning key features in using the Point of Care Sonogram in the Adult Emergency Department and a Busy Trauma Center. Emergency Bedside Sonography is used in Emergency Care to diagnose Gall Bladder Cardiac, Pulmonary, Abdominal Emergencies, Aortic and Vascular Pathology. This workshop will cover key features to techniques for using the right Probes on the right patients to diagnose the right conditions. A considerable amount of time will be spent on hands on training. At the end of the course the Participants will have confidence to use the sonogram in the Adult Emergency Department.

Emergency Clinical Toxicology in India

The Course will focus mainly on the Emergency room management of Toxicology Victims. It will be a practical oriented course with more emphasis on when and what to do without going into theoretical details of the subject. The participants will have an overview of ED management with essential algorithms in the management of Toxicated patients.

Basic and Advanced ECG, Wound Care and Splinting

A practical session on cleaning and suturing a laceration Participants will have the opportunity to practice basic suturing, stapling, taping, and tissue gluing techniques. This workshop will provide lecture, demonstration and hands-on practice for the care of wounds in the acute care setting. Participant will learn to properly assess and manage a wide range of wounds, the use of skin adhesives, taping and staples, the best suture material, hand ties and instrument ties, basic infection information, wound management and healing to include skin cleaning preparation and various suture techniques. This is a hands-on activity-filled session which will

also include various methods to splint bone and joint injuries. Directed by USA Emergency Medicine Faculty the ECG Course will cover all Emergency Rhythms, various Conditions, and treatment pathways. This is a great course which focuses on Emergency ECG Rhythms which need urgent attention and Intervention.

Simulation Education in EMCare

A special workshop on Simulation Education in EM Care to Clinical Situations will be held during the Summit. Specific Scenarios and solutions to high risk situations will also be discussed. Creating, encouraging and fostering leadership to conceive, implement a Simulation Based Education Program is an important mission of this skills session. Simulation Based teaching materials which are tailor made to the Indian Education Environments with live exercises and scenario management discussions will be a part of this skill school.

Pediatric Orthopedic Trauma Skill School

This training is Specially Designed as a Hands on Skill School for Pediatric Orthopedic Trauma Management. It will focus on Complex Management Skills of Single and Multiple Bone and Muscle Injuries in pediatric patients arriving at the Trauma Center. There will be models available for hands on sessions and time is preserved for experts to interact with the delegates.

Fundamentals of Resuscitation in Trauma (FORT)

The sessions will focus mainly on the Emergency room management of Trauma Victims. It will be a practical oriented course with more emphasis on when and what to do without going into theoretical details of the subject. The participants will have an overview of ED management with essential algorithms in the management of Trauma patients.

Emergency Nursing & Pre-Hospital Skills (20th October)

This workshop will be offered to Nurses and Paramedics and will focus on teaching the Nurses and Paramedics lifesaving procedures which are needed to be a part of the Emergency Response team involving critical emergency patients.

A Councilor can be a member of one of more Councils. You have to get a Proof or Letter from the Head of the Institution Asserting your Position as Practicing Clinician/ Academic Faculty/Resident with the letter recommending your nomination to one or more Councils.

The Annual Fee for Nomination to the Councils is 2500 Rupees per Council per year. If you are an Honorable Councilor to all the 4/5 Leadership Councils then the collective fee is 7500 Rupees annually. Residents have to pay 1000 Rupees per Council and 1500 Rupees for joint Resident Councilorship of all three Councils on an annual basis. (*FLAME Councilorship is open only to Female Leaders)

International Councilors have to be a standard membership due of 150 USD per year for all the councils.

The Councilors will be awarded the "Councilor Citation" after you attend the Annual INDUSEM Summit, the INDUSEM General Assembly and Meetings of your Council during the Summit.





INDUS Network of Critical Illness and Injury Translational Trial Experts

The Sixth Annual Meeting of the INDUS Network of Critical Illness and Injury Translational Trial Experts (INCIITTE) will be held at Bengaluru, India as a part of the 12th Annual INDO-US World Congress of Emergency Medicine to be held from 21st to 23rd October 2016.

Translational Research is the need of the hour. India is the new hub for research and the world is looking to take science from Benchside to Bedside and Beyond.

In India there is a separatist ideology will Basic Scientist, Clinical Researchers and Public Health Investigators do not work together on innovation. The result is that ideas get restricted to the boundaries of laboratories or clinics or communities.

INCIITTE is an effort to boost translational research in Medicine focusing on the area of Critical Illness and Injury and working to bring together Basic Scientists, Clinicians and Public Health experts for the benefit of translational science.

Various Researchers are encouraged to submit ideas at the INCIITTE meeting out of which few ideas are selected and encouraged to be formatted and get funded in order to promote research in Critical Illness and Injury Science in India.

Over 100 ideas were submitted and the Top 10 which were selected for being coached for funding were:

1. Relation of Immuno-inflammatory, Biochemical and Genetic (Mitochondrial Gene Polymorphism) Markers with Outcome of Patients presenting with Acute Heart Failure with and without Cardiogenic Shock
 2. To Study the role of NF-kB and cytokines mRNA expression in pulmonary trauma associated with abdominal trauma for post-injury organ dysfunction & Sepsis.
 3. Developing and Testing a Trauma Care Model in Remote Rural Health Care Centers
 4. Immunological , Neuroendocrinal, Coagulopathic Correlates pre and Post Blood and Blood Products Transfusion in Trauma Shock-Sepsis
 5. Endocrinal Markers and Cytokine Correlates of Hyperglycemia Pre versus Post, Intensive versus Regular Correction in Trauma Sepsis Patients
 6. Osteogenic Immunology to Predict Healing Time in Polytrauma to Extremity Bones
 7. Flutemide Injections to Modify Estrogen Effects post Trauma Shock and study of cytokine Polymorphism
 8. Immunological and Neuro chemical cum coagulopathic responses pre and post anti snake venoms in snake bite trauma victims
 9. Proteonomics of Kidney Injury in Post Trauma Shock in Children
 10. Mapping the Immunological markers and their relation to cognitive deficits in children with or without head injury presenting with or without shock.
