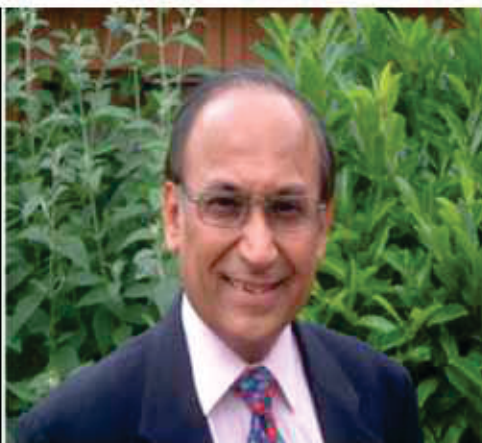

INDUSEM Leader-BAPIO Chief Gets "Order Of The British Empire"



INDUSEM Partner The British Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (BAPIO) is led by its Dynamic President Dr. Ramesh Mehta.

The Queen's Birthday Honors List announced on 16th June 2017 recognized Dr. Mehta with an appointment of the Officer Of The Order of British Empire (OBE) (Equivalent to Padmabhushan in India) for services to the NHS (National Health Service).

Dr. Mehta, a graduate of Government Medical College Nagpur moved to UK in 1981 and served as a consultant and lead Pediatrician at Bedford Hospital. He has provided exemplary services to the NHS, spanning over thirty years.

His professional leadership as a Pediatrician has helped modernize local and regional Child Health services. He has influenced policy making decisions regarding the health care of children nationally.

His various roles have included Chairman for the East of England Pediatric Development Group, Council member for the Royal College of Pediatrics and Child Health, Vice Chair for MRCPCH part 2 Examination Board, Member of the standards setting group in pediatrics & neonatology of General Medical Council and Reviewer for Health Care Commission.

Dr. Mehta has contributed significantly at national level on issues related to supporting equality and diversity for NHS professionals.

His passion to promote professional excellence and leadership, particularly amongst Indian doctors in UK, led him to create a new voluntary body in 1996, The British Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (BAPIO). It has become the most influential national organization of Doctors in UK.

The 2017 Academic College of Emergency Experts and Academy of Family Physicians of India position statement on preventing violence against health-care workers and vandalization of health-care facilities in India

Academic leaders from INDUSEM-ACEE-AFPI in Emergency Medicine, Pediatrics, Family Medicine, Surgery and Indian Society of Preventive and Social Medicine Came together to draft the comprehensive Position Paper on Violence against Doctors and attack on health care establishments.

This is the first time that a Position Paper of this magnitude has been published in a PubMed Indexed Journal.

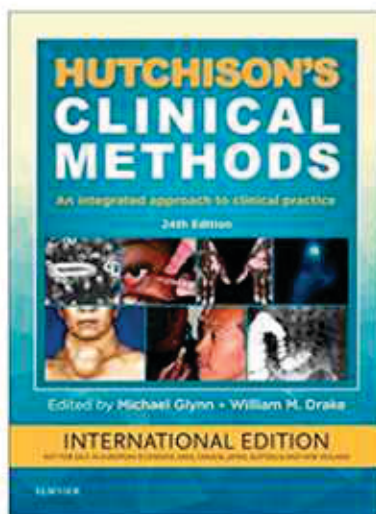
